Hello Elisabeth,

As discussed on July 22nd, 2024, please find attached the final access road alignment chosen by Torngat Metals, Option C1, henceforth referred to as the preferred access road alignment.

The road will lead to Voisey's Bay and will require the construction of a floating dock. Some facilities will have to be built on the shore, such as a fuel farm, container storage, a small repair shop and a small camp. This road will not lead to Anaktalak Bay and Torngat Metals will not be using their facilities. It is important to note, that even if the access road had ended in Anaktalak Bay, we would still have needed to build the above-mentioned infrastructures, except for the floating dock.
